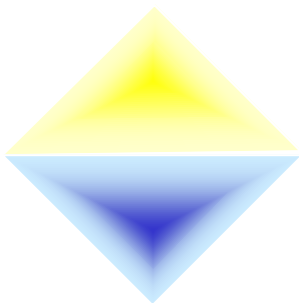

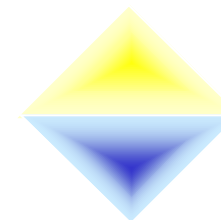
Proceedings

General Scope

This International Conference on High Pressure Process Technology and Chemical Engineering is the fourth of a series of symposia organised by the European Federation of Chemical Engineering (EFCE), after those held in Erlangen (1984 and 1990) and Zürich (1996). Nowadays chemical and in general process technology at high pressure are receiving special interest. A number of new, promising and efficient high-pressure processes for reaction, separation, precipitation and material treatment stimulate scientific challenge and industrial interests alike. This event is a unique chance for high-pressure engineers, chemists, physicists, food technologists, pharmaceutical technologists and biologists to meet and discuss ideas, solutions and future issues on high-pressure applications.

Scientific Program

The Symposium will be held over three days. The program includes plenary and oral communications (three parallel sessions), and poster sessions. The scientific program will encompass all most recent advances in high-pressure process technology and chemical engineering.

Main topics of the scientific program will be:

- Chemical Reaction Engineering
- Biochemical Reactions and Bioprocesses
- Separation Processes and Phase Equilibria
- Material processing
- Plant, Apparatus, Machinery, Measurements, Control
- Applications to Chemical, Food, Pharmaceutical and Cosmetic Industries
