Marc-Olivier COPPENS is Ramsay Memorial Professor in Chemical Engineering at UCL, since 2012, after professorships at Rensselaer and TU Delft. He is also Vice-Dean for Engineering (Interdisciplinarity, Innovation). He directs the Centre for Nature-Inspired Engineering, which was granted EPSRC "Frontier Engineering" (2013) and "Progression" (2019) Awards. He is most recognised for pioneering nature-inspired chemical engineering (NICE) over the past 25 years and developing a systematic nature-inspired solution methodology to accelerate innovation and address Grand Challenges, associated to sustainable development. He is Fellow of IChemE, AIChE, RSC, Corresponding Member of the Saxon Academy of Sciences (Germany), Qiushi Professor at Zhejiang University (China), Scientific Council Member for IFP Energies nouvelles (France), and serves on advisory and editorial boards, including Editor-in-Chief of *Chemical Engineering & Processing: Process Intensification*.
