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He graduated in Chemical Engineering at the University of Rome I in 1974, where he started his university career from assistant professor of Chemical Engineering to associate professor of Food Process Engineering. He was visiting researcher at the National College of Food Technology of the Univ. of Reading (Weybridge, UK); full professor of *Food Processing* at the University of Basilicata and Director of the Institute of Agricultural and Forestry Microbiology and Technology. He was President of the *Italian Society of Food Science and Technology* (SISTAL) from 2006 to 2009, vice-President of SISTAL from 2009 to 2012, and appeal board member of SISTAL from 2012 to 2015. Italian delegate at the Food Working Party (Eur. Federation of Chem. Engng) from 1990 to 2015, and member of the Editorial Board of the *Journal of Food Engineering* from 1994 to 2017.

His research activity has dealt with the development of several fermentation and enzymatic processes, membrane processes, and assessment of the environmental impact of food products and dietary choices. He has so far published 217 papers in qualified journals and presented 176 (oral and/or poster) communications to domestic and/or international congresses.
