Piero Salatino is Professor of Chemical Engineering at the University of Naples Federico II. His career has encompassed senior academic leadership roles, institutional service, and internationally recognised research in chemical engineering. He has served as Chairman of the Chemical Engineering Programme, Dean of the Schools of Engineering and Polytechnic and Basic Sciences, and Director of the CNR Institute for Combustion Research. He has also held major scientific, editorial and technology-transfer roles. His research focuses on chemical reaction engineering, powder technology, fluid-particle systems, the thermochemical conversion of fuels, biomass and waste, industrial bioprocesses, the capture of CO₂, industrial ecology and green engineering. He has authored almost 350 peer-reviewed ISI journal articles, holds nine patents and has delivered over 40 plenary, keynote and invited lectures.
